



Fall Baseball/Softball Information

Online registration opens on Monday 5/26/2008 for the Fall Season. Follow the web link on the website (www.hartbaseball.org) to register.

There will be no walk-in dates for registration. You must register online to play in the fall. You are also welcome to come to the canteen and use the canteen computer to register. Although we may have limited space available during tryouts there is no guarantee that we will be accepting any walk in registrations for the fall 2008 season.

The fall league is an instructional league and the season typically consists of eight (8) games. No standings are kept and only one (1) umpire is provided per game.

We do not currently offer a fall program for the Shetland (baseball) or Filly (softball) divisions.

Registration fees for the fall program are \$100.00 per player for each league plus a \$50 (per family) volunteer fee which can be refunded if you work a two (2) hour shift in the canteen or other capacity.

The fall program uses the following year's age cutoff. See the information below for proper league placement.

Information for new players:

If you are new to the league you must supply a birth certificate PRIOR to your son/daughter trying out. For tryouts each player should dress in baseball/softball attire, (pants/jersey/cleats/hat) and have a glove. Bats and helmets are strongly suggested, however the league will supply helmets, and the player can borrow a bat to tryout out if required. Facemasks ARE REQUIRED at the Pinto level.
